2008 Cassegrain Reserve Verdehlo (Hunter Valley, NSW) 29

A grassy style with Tropical fruit, jasmine and green tea – very dry

2008 Belgravia Chardonnay (Orange, NSW) 45

Fresh, vibrant natural acidity. White peach and citrus, lightly toasted oak. Drink with Salmon, Roast chicken and soft cheeses

2007 Ata Rang Petrie Chardonnay (Martinborough, NZ) 50

Citrus blossom, mandarin and jasmine with a hint of almond on the nose. Chalky minerality on the palate, fruit with a hint of savoury

2008 Tomaresca Chardonnay (Puglia, Italy) 37

Shows apple, lemon and honey on the nose and palate. Fresh acidity. From the far south of Italy - Puglia being a region which produces more wine than the whole of Australia.

2006 Devil's Lair Chardonnay (Margaret River, WA) 59

Nose of pear essence and hazelnut with a crème brulee palette

2007 Tuck's Ridge Turrumurra Chardonnay (Yarra Valley, VIC) 80

Grapefruit and white peach flavors with great oak- Halliday says 96/100....

2006 Louis Jadot Saint Veran (Maconnais, France) 60

Dry, delicate and youthful. Subtle nutty flavour and soft roundness. Pale gold in colour

2005 Mount Mary Chardonnay (Yarra Valley, VIC) 110

Elegant, Refined. Nectarine and Melon Fruit with perfect oak balance. Long, clean finish

2004/5 Leeuwin Estate Art Series Chardonnay (Margaret River, WA) 120

Ripe peach and pear, hints of fig and cashew. Finely balanced Bouquet. Long and full flavoured finish

2007/8 Trinity Hill Pinot Gris (Hawkes Bay, NZ) 46

Nashi Pear and Spice. Dry with great balance, finesse and purity of fruit.

2008 Scorpo Pinot Gris (Mornington Peninsula, VIC) 55

Spiced pear and candied lemon, a layered and fresh palate with ripe pear and crisp minerality. A lovely, and typical pinot gris

2008 Corte Giar Pinot Grigio (Veneto, Italy) 44

Pears and stewed apple with a custard note

2007 TR Gaba do Xil Godello (Vadeorras, Spain) 45

Peach, melon and honey on the nose. Oily, silky mouthfeel. Feels and tastes like it should be sweet, but actually quite savoury. Great aromatics and flavour profile - Spanish pinot gris?

2007 Kilikanoon Mort's Block Riesling (Clare Valley, SA) 33

Lemon, lime and green apple- acidic and fresh

2008 Rockford Vine Vale Riesling (Eden Valley, SA) 49

Straw yellow- grapefruit, lime and faint rockmelon on the nose. Quite floral palate with firm acid

2007 Egon Muller Scharzhofberger Qualitats Riesling (Mosel, Germany) 60

Off dry sweetness balanced with minerality from slate soils

2006 Envoy Gewurtztraminer (Marlborough, New Zealand) 55

Manuka Honey, Ripe Citrus and Rose Petal. Spicy and rich on the palate with some sweetness. Good length

2008 Rockford White Frontignac (Barossa, SA) 45

Sweet and grapey but there's also some lemon zest/sherbet that adds interest; the palate's more zingy with sweet lemony fruit and very good length.

2009 Margan Family Semillon (Hunter Valley, NSW) 39

Pure citrus characters, ripe fruit on the palate and a crisp clean acid finish. A classic Hunter Semillon

2005 Rockford Local Growers Semillon 49

A touch of oak intermingled with citrus and butter.

2008 Philip Shaw No. 19 Sauvignon Blanc (Orange, NSW) 42

Refined gooseberry fruit on the nose. Mineral acidity on the palate with herb, grass, asparagus and gooseberry. Long finish. Just as good (if not better than) Marlborough savvies. Buy Australian!

2008 O:TU Sauvignon Blanc (Marlborough, New Zealand) 39

Award winning Marlborough savvy with zesty mineral elegance, lime and gooseberry characters with a crisp and clean finish

2008 Craggy Range Te Muna Sauvignon Blanc (Martinborough, New Zealand) 60

Packed with stone fruit, lime, grapefruit and mineral characters. Richly textured with an incredibly long and powerful, yet crisp and clean finish

2008 Domaine Christian Salmon Sancerre (Sancerre, France) 60

Intense, flinty, mineral notes -passionfruit and gooseberry character not as evident as in new world Sav. Blanc. Typically aromatic, and opens up with air. Surprisingly rich on the palate.

2007 Telmo Rodriguez 'BASA' Verdejo (Rueda, Spain) 39

A fresh straw colour with aromas of herb and grass. Tart apple and lemon on the palate with fresh acid and a slight oiliness. Verdejo is a grape with similar characteristics to Sauvignon Blanc.

2006 Castro Martin Albariño (Rias Baixas, Spain) 50

A distinct oily minerality on the nose, then clean fresh white fruit. A steely precision on the palate but also lots of fruit - peach, pear. Vivid lemon and mineral acidity. Spain's best grape and one you'll see more of with good reason.

2006 Cantina Pra Soave Classico (Veneto, Italy) 48

Nose of flowers, minerals with underlying pineapple, hay and lemon. Steely minerality on the palate, with citrus, pineapple and a hint of bitter almonds
